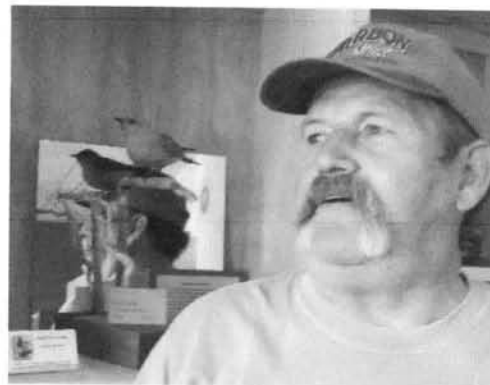
Sat. Feb. 18 Acrylic Workshop, Deloras Fredericks, instructor. Members- \$25, Non- \$35. Supply list available upon registration.
